The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The first appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 1 October 2006, ended by reason of redundancy on 3 April 2009. His gross weekly pay had been €581.56.

The second appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 1 October 2005, ended by reason of redundancy on 3 April 2009. His gross weekly pay had been €571.02.

No contesting evidence was offered at the hearing by the respondent.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the first appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 21 September 1976
Date of commencement: 01 October 2006
Date of termination: 03 April 2009
Gross weekly pay: €581.56

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the second appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 25 January 1955
Date of commencement: 01 October 2005
Date of termination: 03 April 2009
Gross weekly pay: €571.02

These awards are made subject to the appellants having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
