## **Determination**

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 15<sup>th</sup> September 1969 1<sup>st</sup> September 2002 1<sup>st</sup> August 2008 €672.44

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. A ceiling of €600 per week applies to any payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

The Tribunal award the appellant the amount of €2689.76 being the equivalent of four weeks pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 – 2005.
