The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant was let go from his employment on April 12th 2008. He lodged a claim with the Employment Appeals Tribunal on July 13th 2009, this being 14 months are his dismissal. The time limit for lodging an appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is 52 weeks but this can be extended by the Tribunal if they find there were reasonable circumstances.

Determination

Having heard sworn evidence the Tribunal has considered the time limit for receipt of appeals under Section 24 of the Redundancy Payments Act 1967 as amended by section 12 of the Redundancy Payments Act 1971 and Section 13 of the Redundancy Payments Act 1979 and has decided to allow the appellant to present his case.

The Tribunal finds that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum, which is to be calculated on the basis of the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 01 May 1981

Date of Commencement: 12 September 2005

Date of Termination: 12 April 2008

Gross Pay: € 550.00
