The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Managing Director conceded that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum. Giving sworn evidence the appellant stated he had applied to the redundancy section for a lump sum payment but to date he had not received this payment.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of birth:	3 March 1947
Date of commencement:	8 March 1981
Date of termination:	28 February 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€750.00

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social

Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
