There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent. The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of the hearing.

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 30th August 1999 and was made redundant on 25th June 2010. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €530.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.
