The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The appellant informed the Tribunal that he had received his full redundancy entitlement since filing form T1A but he had not received monies in lieu of notice.

Determination:

The Tribunal dismisses the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the appellant having received his entitlement under these Acts.

The Tribunal awards the sum of €6,542.40 (being the equivalent of eight weeks' gross pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
