Determination

The respondent by letter dated the 29th of November 2010 conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The respondent has paid the appellant €1,639.78 being the equivalent to 40% of her redundancy lump sum entitlement. This amount should be deducted from the appellant's redundancy payment. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	31 st May 1978
Date of commencement of employment:	20 th October 2000
Date of termination of employment:	30 th May 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€228.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
