The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The only issue between the parties was the continuity of employment of the appellant when a transfer of undertakings was effected early during the employment. The Transfer of Undertakings Regulations were brought to the attention of the respondent whereupon the respondent conceded liability under the Redundancy Payments Acts. Accordingly, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 1 October 1983 6 March 2007 26 March 2009 €485-00 This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
