The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

In accepting that the appellant was made redundant the respondent indicated that the company did not have the resources to discharge a redundancy payment to him. Having satisfied itself that the appellant's employment with the respondent was terminated by way of redundancy the Tribunal allows the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 and awards the appellant a statutory lump sum under those Acts, and based on the following:
