This case came before the Tribunal by way of an employer appealing the decision of a Rights Commissioner ref: r-069689-pw-08/DI.

The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The respondent's representative contended that neither he nor the respondent had been served a copy of the notice of appeal as specified under section 7 (2) (b) of the Payment of Wages Act, 1991. The appellant was unable produce any documentary evidence to show that this section had been complied with. He had a representation at the time the appeal was lodged and could not verify whether a copy was sent to the other party.

## **Determination:**

Having heard and noted the respondent's representative's submission on the application of this appeal the Tribunal finds that it has no jurisdiction to hear this case based on section 7 (2) (b) of the Payment of Wages Act, 1991. Accordingly the decision of the Rights Commissioner ref: r-069689-pw-08/DI stands.
