Determination:

Having heard the uncontested evidence adduced by the appellant the Tribunal determines that a redundancy situation occurred. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, succeeds and awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum, which is to be calculated on the basis of the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 12th August 1952

Date of Commencement: 09th April 2001

Date of Termination: 04th April 2009

Gross Pay: € 922.50

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. A statutory gross weekly ceiling of €600.00, applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
