Determination

The respondent having conceded liability in this regard, the Tribunal finds the appellants are entitled to redundancy lump sum payments under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Appellant No 1.

Date of Birth: 4 December 1976
Date of commencement of employment: 7 March 2001
Date of termination of employment: 10 April 2009
Gross weekly pay: €556.53

This appellant accepted that he had already received a part payment in respect of his redundancy in the amount of €3666.67.

Appellant No 2.

Date of Birth: 12 February 1975
Date of commencement of employment: 12 May 1997
Date of termination of employment: 24 April 2009
Gross weekly pay: €673.14

This appellant accepted that he had already received a part payment in respect of his redundancy in the amount of €5937.60.

These awards are made subject to the appellants having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Please note that a weekly ceiling of €600 applies to all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
