The determination of the Tribunal was as follows: -

This case came before the Tribunal as a result of appeals by the employer (the appellant) against a decision of the Rights Commissioner under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991 **R-074859-PW-09** and recommendations of the Rights Commissioner under both the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994 to 2001 **R-074858-TE-09** and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 **R-074857-WT-09**, in the case of an employee (the respondent).

Determination

The Tribunal being satisfied that the parties were properly on notice of the hearing, the appeals under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991, the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994 to 2001 and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 all fail for want of prosecution.
