This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Allowing the claim lodged under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of $\notin 2,480.00$ (this amount being equivalent to eight weeks' gross pay at $\notin 310.00$ per week).
