Determination

The respondent having conceded liability in this regard, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth:	16 February 1955
Date of commencement of employment:	1 January 1977
Date of termination of employment:	23 March 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€643.87

The Tribunal heard evidence from the respondent that a part redundancy payment of €15,528.00 had already been made to the appellant and this evidence was accepted by the appellant.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Please note that a weekly ceiling of €600 applies to all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
