The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent. The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of the hearing.

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on  $20^{\text{th}}$  October 2006 and was let go when the business closed down on  $29^{\text{th}}$  November 2009. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €281.68 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

## **Determination**

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Termination date	29 <sup>th</sup> November 2009
Gross pay	€281.68 per week
