The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The Tribunal being satisfied that the first named appellant was properly on notice of the hearing his appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts fails for want of prosecution. Being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice the Tribunal proceeded with the hearing of the second named appellant's appeal. Based on the uncontroverted evidence the Tribunal is satisfied that the second named appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria
