This case came before the Tribunal by way of an appeal by the former employer against a decision by a rights commissioner reference number r-077137-pw-09/SR

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the appellant nor a representative on its behalf appeared for this hearing.

Accordingly, The appeal under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991 is dismissed for want of prosecution. The Tribunal upholds the decision of the Rights commissioner in this case and re-affirms the award of € 1,184.40 to the respondent under that Act.
