There was no appearance or representation on behalf of the respondent. The Tribunal is satisfied that proper notification was sent to the respondent.

The Tribunal heard evidence from the appellant.

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 19 February 2003, ended without notice by reason of redundancy on 4 September 2009.

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Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 22 July 1979
Date of commencement: 19 February 2003
Date of termination: 04 September 2009

Gross weekly pay: €566.02

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Allowing the claim lodged under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €2,264.08 (this amount being equivalent to four weeks' gross pay at €566.02 per week).
