Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant that she was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal awards her a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of birth:	2 nd June 1976
Date of commencement of employment:	1 st November 2004
Date of termination of employment:	26 th December 2008
Gross weekly pay:	€601.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. The appellant agreed a payment with her employer of €6400.00 as a redundancy package. She was paid €2500.00 in 2008, but has not received any further payments to date.

Please note a ceiling of €600.00 applies to all payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
