The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 10th August 1987
Date of Commencement: 30th July 2007
Date of Termination: 5th February 2010

Gross Pay: € 525.72

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant's employment was terminated without notice, accordingly award him €1051.44, being the equivalent to 2 weeks pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 To 2005.

The Tribunal find that the appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997 succeeds and awards the appellant €175.23 being 1.66 days holiday pay.
