Determination

The Tribunal, being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing, finds based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, that she is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria;

Date of Birth: 16th March 1981

Employment Commenced: 4th January 2006

Employment Ended: 24th April 2009

Gross Weekly Pay: €643.85
