Determination

This case came before the Tribunal by way of the appellant (the employee) appealing against the recommendation of a Rights Commissioner under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007 ref: r074314-ud-09/EOS.

The Tribunal is satisfied based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant that he was unfairly selected for redundancy thus upsetting the recommendation of the Rights Commissioner. The Tribunal finds that compensation is the appropriate remedy and taking into account the evidence heard in relation to loss awards the claimant the sum of €19,300.11 under the Unfair

Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007.
