The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

The claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007, was withdrawn at the outset of the hearing.

The claimant gave evidence with the assistance of a Tribunal appointed translator. He was informed on 21st August 2009 that there would be no further work for a period of some two or three weeks. The foreman informed the claimant that when work became available he would return to work. However, no further work became available and the claimant subsequently received a P45, which was backdated to the 21st August 2009.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied from the uncontested evidence that the claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and find that the lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, should be based on the following criteria:

Date of Termination:	21st August 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€311.16
Amount of Redundancy:	€2,159.45
