The appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy.

The appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 17 April 1950
Service from: 5 June 2001 to 4 December 2009
Normal weekly remuneration: €1020.00

Non-reckonable service: Nil
Amount of redundancy payment: €10,812.00

The Tribunal awards the appellant €4080.00 compensation (this being the equivalent of four weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

Appellant No 2

The appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy.

The appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 5 April 1981
Service from: 5 June 2004 to 4 December 2009
Normal weekly remuneration: €900.65
Non-reckonable service: Nil
Amount of redundancy payment: €7200.00

The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005 fails.

A weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to any payments from the Social Insurance Fund and these awards are subject to the appellants having been in employment which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.
