The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

There was no appearance by or representation on behalf of the Receiver. The Tribunal is satisfied that the Receiver was on notice of the hearing.

The claimant gave evidence that his employment with the respondent company commenced on September 13^{th} 2007. He worked in a team providing technical servicing to a chain of supermarkets. He contended that on May 29th 2009 he was told that he was dismissed. He was not given any notice pay. He was paid for his holidays in 2008, but had only taken five days leave in 2009. He earned €600.00 gross pay per week. He was the longest serving employee in the company. Other employees remained with the company until it went into receivership in August2009. He remained in Ireland seeking work for two months after his dismissal. He then went hometo Poland where he got a job in October 2009.

Determination:

Based on the uncontested evidence of the claimant the Tribunal finds that he was unfairly dismissed from his position. Accordingly, claim under Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007, succeeds and the Tribunal awards the claimant $\in 10,200$ (ten thousand two hundred euro) based on 17 weeks at $\in 600.00$ (six hundred euro). The Tribunal awards the claimant $\in 600.00$ (six hundred euro) in respect of one week's notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. The Tribunal awards the claimant $\notin 480.00$ (four hundred and eighty euro) in respect of fourdays' holiday pay under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
