Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant that he was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal awards him a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 18th April 1970

Date of commencement of employment: 20th March 2003

Date of termination of employment: 03rd October 2009

Gross weekly pay: €700.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appellant is awarded two weeks annual leave under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600 per week.
