The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant gave evidence that his employment as a nightclub security guard commenced on August 16<sup>th</sup> 2006. In 2008 he earned an average of €147.32 per week. On August 20<sup>th</sup> 2009 he received his P45 with his wages. He was not told anything by the management. He heard from a colleague that an outside company was taking over the security role.

No evidence was adduced on behalf of the respondent.

## **Determination:**

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation existed and that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 6<sup>th</sup> December 1973
Date of Commencement: 16<sup>th</sup> August 2006
Date of Termination: 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2009

Weekly Gross Pay: €147.32

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal awards the appellant €294.64 (two hundred and ninety-four euro sixty-four cent) in respect of two weeks' pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. The date of termination has been amended to reflect this award.
