It was accepted by the respondent that a redundancy situation existed in this case.

Accordingly the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth	6 th October 1959
Employment commenced	10 th April 2000
Employment ended	25 th June 2009
Gross weekly pay	€ 800.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week
