This case came before the Tribunal by way of an appeal by the employer, appellant, against the recommendations of a Rights Commissioner r-078530-te-09/JW, r-078529-wt-09/JW, r-078699-te-09/JW, r-078688-wt-09/JW, r-078532-te-09/JW and r-078533-wt-09/JW.

Determination

The Tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear the appeals under Sections 11, 12, 14, 15, or 19 of the Organisation of Working time Act 1997.

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was properly notified of the hearing. However he did not appear or send a representative. Accordingly, the appeal against the recommendations of the Rights Commissioner under the Terms of Employment (Information) Acts 1994 and 2001 fails for want of prosecution. These recommendations are upheld.
