The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 16 January 2006, ended by reason of redundancy on 19 December 2008. There were no breaks in his service. His gross weekly pay was €600.00.

A hearing notice was sent to the respondent but no evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent at the hearing.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 26 January 1983
Date of commencement: 16 January 2006

Date of termination: 19 December 2008
Gross weekly pay: €600.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
