## The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The liquidator was not in a position to either concede or dispute the claims made.

### **Determination:**

Based on his uncontested evidence the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 10<sup>th</sup> June 1975 Date of Commencement: 1<sup>st</sup> April 2003

Date of Termination: 28<sup>th</sup> September 2009

Gross Weekly Pay: €423.43

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to the sum of €1,693.72 (being the equivalent of four weeks' gross pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

There were no details adduced regarding the claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, accordingly the claim is dismissed for want of prosecution.
