The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor its listed representative or any representative on its behalf appeared for this hearing.

Having heard and considered the brief submission of the appellant the Tribunal finds that his employment was terminated by reason of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a statutory redundancy lump sum payment under those Acts, and based on the following:
