Determination

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	22 nd March 1957
Date of Commencement:	5 th December 2001
Date of Termination:	31 st July 2009
Gross Pay:	€646.03

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund. Please note that this award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period
