There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent and the Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of the hearing.

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 24th September 1994 and was let go without notice on 31st July 2009 having been told that there was no more work available. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €760.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him €5,560.00 under the Minimum Notice And Terms Of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

This award is made subject to the claimant having been in insurable employment, during the relevant period, in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts.
