The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

Being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing, the Tribunal finds, based on the uncontroverted evidence, that the appellants were dismissed by reason of redundancy and, accordingly, are entitled to lump sum payments under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the criteria set out in the following schedule. The third and fourth named appellants are further entitled to payments under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 as also set out in the schedule. The appeal of the second named appellant under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 was withdrawn at the outset.
