The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007 was withdrawn from the outset of the hearing. The claim under the Minimum notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, was withdrawn at the outset of the hearing.

The Tribunal heard evidence from both parties as to the redundancy matter. The Tribunal having heard the evidence determine that a redundancy situation existed and that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:

Date of Termination: 29th October 2008
Weekly Gross Pay: €1,400.00
