Determination

The claimant commenced work as a barman in August 2008. The Tribunal heard uncontradicted evidence from the claimant whose employment was unilaterally terminated by the respondent company on or about the 1 February 2010. The dismissal was unfair in all the circumstances and the claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts succeeds.

The claimant has made every effort to find alternative employment and whilst he has had some success his gross weekly income has fallen short of what he was earning in the respondent company. The Tribunal awards the claimant the sum of €16,094.00 compensation for loss of earnings under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007.
