Claimant's Case

The claimant commenced employment on 01 August 2001. Before the claimant went on holidays in July 2009 the respondent informed him that there might not be any work available for him on his return. The claimant tried on a number of occasions to contact the respondent on and after his return but the respondent did not answer his phone calls. Nor did he receive a reply to his letter. The respondent company has since closed.

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was on notice of the hearing. Having heard the uncontested evidence of the claimant the Tribunal find that his employment with the respondent was terminated by reason of redundancy. The Tribunal awards the claimant a lump sum redundancy
