#### **Determination**

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of birth:	1 <sup>st</sup> July 1956
Date employment commenced	18 <sup>th</sup> September 2006
Date employment ceased	9 <sup>th</sup> April 2009
Gross weekly pay	€650.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

There is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
