Determination

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation did exist. The Tribunal find that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. The appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on:

Date of Birth:	25 th September 1966
Service from:	28 th January 2007 to 24 th July 2009
Normal weekly remuneration:	€400.00
Non-reckonable service:	nil
Amount of redundancy payment:	€2,392.00

A ceiling of €600.00 applies to any payments from the Social Insurance Fund and this award

is subject to the appellant having been in employment, which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Consolidation Act 2005.
