The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

## **Determination**

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal heard evidence from the appellant that he served a RP9 on the respondent and that his termination date was the 25<sup>th</sup>

September 2009.	The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under
the Redundancy F	ayments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of birth	16 <sup>th</sup> February 1952
Date employment commenced	15 <sup>th</sup> December 1989
Date employment ceased	25 <sup>th</sup> September 2009
Gross weekly pay	€ 440.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Loss having been established, the Tribunal awards the sum of €2,640, this being six weeks gross pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
