Determination:

There was no appearance by either the claimant or a representative on her behalf or the respondent or a representative on their behalf on the day of the hearing and the Tribunal are satisfied that both parties were properly notified of it.

The claimant when making her claim for unfair dismissal to the Employment Appeals Tribunal did not object to the Rights Commissioner hearing it. The claimant also made a claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 to the Rights Commissioners, which was duly heard on April 16th 2010.
