Determination

The Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation existed and therefore the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:-

Date of birth:	19 th August 1951
Date employment began	1 st April 1974
Date employment ended	14 th August 2009
Gross weekly pay	€880.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment during the relevant period under the Social Welfare Acts.

There is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
