### Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of this hearing. The Tribunalheard evidence in relation to the appellant's termination date and particulars of employment. Basedon the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds she is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of birth Date employment commenced Date employment ceased Gross weekly pay 16<sup>th</sup> December 1967 7<sup>th</sup> July 2007 5<sup>th</sup> November 2009 €450.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal find that the appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973

to 2005 fails as, by the appellant's own evidence she received notice on the 18<sup>th</sup> of October 2009.
