Determination:

Having heard the evidence adduced by the appellants and the documentation submitted the Tribunal finds that the appellants were made redundant. The respondent confirmed their redundancies and stated he had an inability to pay them.

Accordingly, the appeals under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeed and the Tribunal award the appellants a redundancy lump sum, which is to be calculated on the basis of the following criteria:
