**Determination**

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 27<sup>th</sup> May 1929  
Date of Commencement: 25<sup>th</sup> January 1988  
Date of Termination: 7<sup>th</sup> May 2010  
Gross Pay: €595.66

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
