The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly served with notice of the hearing.

The claim for redundancy was withdrawn at the outset of the hearing.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant was given three days notice while he was entitled to four weeks. The Tribunal awards the appellant €1,904.00 compensation (this being the equivalent of 3.4weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
