The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

The claimant stated that after she was let go from her employment on 31st August 2009, the shop she had worked in closed down. It re-opened two weeks later under new ownership and some of the previous staff were re-employed. The claimant stated that her old job was advertised. She did not receive the Minimum Notice due to her. The claim under the Unfair Dismissal Acts was withdrawn during the hearing.

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied the above named liquidator was appointed. A letter was received dated 31 May 2011 in the Tribunal from the liquidator stating that the liquidation of the company was finalised and there would be no distribution to any class of creditors.

The Tribunal awards the appellant her statutory entitlement of €330, being the sum due for two weeks' notice, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
