The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 8 July 2006, ended by reason of redundancy on 9 July 2010. His weekly pay was €600.00. There were no breaks in his service.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent to dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 15 September 1965

Date of commencement: 8 July 2006

Date of termination: 9 July 2010

Weekly pay: €600.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
